About The Wildbrook Radio Network

The Wildbrook Radio Network was created in 2009 by Ryan Gavin and Dan Moriarty as a syndication service network for new radio shows originating from WMEB-FM in Orono, Maine.

In November 2009, the popular “All Maine Points” political news program was in the first phases of state-wide syndication, and a larger media network was needed to make programs produced in Orono available to other media outlets across Maine. The Wildbrook Radio Network successfully brought political news and analysis from Orono to other Maine communities like Biddeford, Saco, Portland, Scarborough, Machias, and Gorham.

After the successful run of “All Maine Points,” The Wildbrook Radio Network served as a host platform and syndication service for political and public affairs programming in two radio markets and online. Both “All Maine Points” and “Rock, Flag & Eagle” originated from WMEB-FM in Orono and served the Bangor market, and “Cardinal Direction” originated from WCUA-FM in Washington, D.C., and served the Baltimore/Washington market.

Currently, The Wildbrook Radio Network produces and syndicates political, public affairs and news-based programming from Maine to media outlets on the east coast and across the country through the web.





All Maine Points

Political News & Talk

“All Maine Points” ran from October 2009 to January 2011 at the University of Maine, airing on WMEB-FM in Orono. The weekly public affairs program was a major source of political and campaign news for members of the UMaine and Eastern Maine communities. The program ran in a “news journal” style format during the run-up to the 2010 general election in Maine, featuring guests from both sides of the political aisle, including all Democratic and most Republican candidates for Governor. Other segments included interviews with newsmakers and public servants such as the President of the University of Maine, members of the Maine State Legislature, and others.

Hosted by members of the UMaine College Republicans, “Rock, Flag & Eagle” broadcasted from a secure bunker at WMEB-FM in Orono and was known for its “RFE Hypotheticals” and a comedic spin on both conservative and liberal public policy. For most of the second season, the RFE crew allowed a liberal to join the right-leaning show to provide perspective from the other side of the aisle, and for target practice.

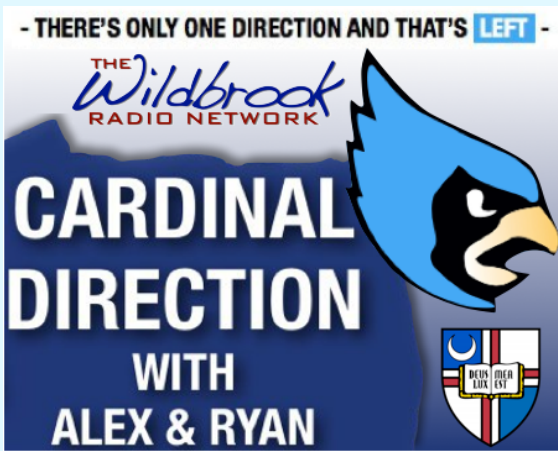

The program aired live weekly from WCUA-FM in Washington, D.C., and was simulcast and rerun on WMEB-FM in Orono, Maine.
